



# Wanted: Auto Museum Volunteers

The new Fountainhead Antique Auto Museum is seeking people to serve as educational ambassadors and help with a variety of museum activities. All applicants should have an interest in automotive and/or Alaska history and must be age 18 or older. Volunteers are needed for the following positions:

- **Museum Docents** lead tours, speak with visitors, and protect displays. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants should enjoy teaching and speaking in front of groups. Applicants are required to complete our free, 4-session training course and are asked to commit to at least two 4.5-hour shifts/month during the summer and two hours/week in the winter.
- **Youth Educators** are docents trained to lead tours and special activities for youth groups. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants should have some experience working with children. Youth educators are required to complete our free docent-training course and are asked to commit to leading 10 tours during the school year.
- **Pit Crew** members are docents trained to clean and detail cars and help set up or move exhibits. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants must complete our free docent course.
- **Road Crew** members are docents trained to drive one or more of the museum cars on the hotel grounds and to special events in the summer (as weather allows). Road Crew members educate visitors about certain cars and encourage hotel guests to visit the museum. Requirements: completion of free docent course, 8 hours of time volunteering in the museum and interacting with visitors, training on specific vehicle(s), Alaska driver's license, clean driving record and ability to interact with the public. Crew members must commit to one shift/week during the summer.
- **General Volunteers** help with a variety of tasks which may include: reception and gift shop assistance; setting up and cleaning clothing displays; database entry; car research; photography; event security; exhibit development; and organization of museum events (open house, etc.).
