



- **Kenwood Yulupa Cuvee Brut Split Sonoma County California**
A light and refreshing, well-balanced sparkling wine with fruit flavors and aromas of citrus, pear and peaches, followed by a nuance of spice. \$9
- **Hogue Columbia Valley Riesling 2009 Columbia Valley Washington**
Opens with a mélange of aromas, orange blossom, jasmine, dried apricot and tangerine. A creamy palate and refreshing finish. \$8
- **Kris Pinot Grigio 2007 Dell Venezi Italy**
Pale yellow in color with brilliant greenish reflections, enticing aromas of acacia flowers, citrus, tangerine, and hints of apricots and almonds. Kris is lean and refreshing on the palate with hints of blossom and honey. \$9
- **Giesen Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Marlborough New Zealand**
Classic nettle and gooseberry flavors combine with dry, citrus flavors on a medium bodied palate. Focused acidity provides length and a refreshing zest to the finish. \$9
- **Cupcake Chardonnay 2009 Central Coast California**
A big, rich Chardonnay from California's desirable Central Coast, where the sun drenched grapes create full and elegantly-textured wines. Decadent layers of butter, cream, bright citrus and vanilla melt into a balance of oak and subtle spice. In other words: Sinful. \$7.50
- **A-Z Pinot Noir 2008 Willamette Valley Oregon**
Lively, refreshing, nice red cherry fruit flavors and hints of red raspberry. A nice food wine with great balance and a long finish. \$9
- **Marietta Old Vine Red Lot 53 Sonoma and Mendocino County California**
Loaded with spicy, peppery, ripe blackberry fruit and backed by dense, blueberry, earthy Petite Syrah flavors. The higher percentage of Petite Syrah adds noticeable complexity to the wine. This is a serious wine, yet eminently approachable... broad and lush on the palate with a lingering finish. \$7.50
- **Cypress Merlot 2008 Central Coast California**
Attractive purple color with red hues, dark cherry and currant aromas. On the palate this wine displays bright fruit characteristics with hints of spice and oak. \$8.50
- **Angeli Cuvee 2006 "Marietta Cellars" Sonoma California**
A blend of Monetpulciano and Negro Amaro. Complex earthy aromas of wild game, anise, dried herbs with intriguingly delicate floral notes. Incredibly unique and elegant wine to swirl, sip and ponder. \$10
- **Kaiken Malbec 2007 Mendoza Argentina**
The wine presents a vivid ruby red color with purple hues. On the mouth, red fruits and elegant spicy touches enhance its complexity, mixing harmoniously with the oak. Soft and silky on the mouth where the wine's fruit intensity is instantly recognizable, blending perfectly with the oak aging. Its unique structure, due to the maturity and softness of its tannins, provides a long and persistent finish. \$7.50
- **Chateauneuf-Du-Pape-Guigal 2003 Rhone France**
Round tannins with powerful complexity. A rich unctuous wine with notes of mature plums, hazelnuts and red fruits. \$10
- **Layer Cake Shiraz 2008 McLaren Vale South Australia**
Dark, dense and creamy, complex aromas of black plum, Bing cherry, blackberry and pepper merge with licorice, tobacco, mocha and dark chocolate. \$9

- **Bin 10 King Estate Pinot Gris 2007 Willamette Valley Oregon**
A bright golden wine with aromas of green apples, pears, peaches and apricots. It offers flavors of lemons, peaches and apricots with a bracing, palate-cleansing acidity. A somewhat abrupt finish with apricots and hints of spice. \$21
- **Bin 11 J. Lohr Riverstone 2006 Chardonnay Monterey County California**
The flavors are very clean, with nectarine, citrus, subtle floral notes and vanilla toastiness, producing layers of complexity with an excellent balance of fresh fruit acidity and palate weight. \$23
- **Bin 12 Sonoma Cutrer Russian River Ranches 2005 Chardonnay Sonoma Coast CA**
Pretty aromas of jasmine and rose petal give way to tropical fruits like pineapple and mango. Roasted hazelnut joins nougat and almond butter, finishing with a touch of lime and lychee. \$23
- **Bin 13 Clos du Bois 2005 Merlot Sonoma County California**
Color of dense black cherry red, aromas of raspberry and black cherry with a touch of vanilla. Sweet tobacco and toasty oak. These rich flavors are encompassed by a silky mouth feel with hints of oak spice and a long finish. \$22
- **Bin 14 J. Lohr Seven Oaks 2007 Cabernet Paso Robles California**
The 2007 J. Lohr Estates Seven Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon is a youthful, dense purple red color with bright hues. The aroma is very generous with black cherry, black currant and plum fruit, complemented by vanilla, char and toasty notes from the twelve to fourteen months in barrel. \$19
- **Bin 15 Serhgesio Zinfandel 2008 Sonoma County California**
The climate induced spice undertones for the 2008 vintage. Velvety mouth feel. Full-bodied, Wine Spectator Top 100 wines for 2008. \$24
- **Bin 16 Domaine Drouhin 2008 Pinot Noir Willamette Valley Oregon**
Delicate and balanced with soft raspberry and spice on the nose, oak and cedar finish. \$32

- **Bin 101 "J" Vintage Brut NV Russian River Valley California**
Fragrant and finely flavored, this exceptional and well-balanced wine, with medium full body, smooth texture and a crisp, long finish. Tastes of pineapple, lemon peel and pear. \$75
- **Bin 102 Schramsberg Blanc de Blanc NV Napa and Mendocino County California**
From Napa's finest sparkling house, a rich, doughy wine full of pear and apple flavors. \$42
- **Bin 103 Martini & Rossi Asti Spumante NV Piedmont Italy**
Sweet and carefree this Asti is perfect for any occasion. \$22

- **Bin 104 Argyle Brut 2005 Willamette Valley Oregon**
The aromas of this 2005 Brut have multi-layered fruit expressions of d'Anjou pear and lemon meringue pie. This wine smells "creamy" with toasted oatmeal, yeasty goodness. Fruit flavors of yellow plum, d'Anjou pear crumble blend well with a hint of honey and a rich mouthfeel of "creamy" texture. The pinpoint bubbles carry the flavor through to a deliciously long, long finish. \$45
- **Bin 105 Kenwood Yulupa NV Cuvee Sonoma County California**
A light and refreshing, well-balanced sparkling wine with fruit flavors and aromas of citrus, pear and peaches, followed by a nuance of spice. \$21

CHAMPAGNE

- **Bin 106 Dom Perignon 1999 Champagne France**
One of the world's most delicate and delightful of all champagnes, this wine will make any occasion truly special. \$195
- **Bin 107 Veuve Cliquot Yellow Label NV Champagne France**
Doughy aromas and crisp apple notes. This classic from France is truly a world class champagne. \$85

CHARDONNAY

- **Bin 201 Robert Mondavi Reserve 2004 Napa Valley California**
Full of wonderful soft pear and apple flavors with very round notes of vanilla and oak. \$65
- **Bin 202 Chateau Montelena 2007 Napa Valley California**
On the palate the clean, soft, full entry builds with layers of tropical fruit, white melon, green apple, and citrus. Excellent weight and acid balance throughout refresh the palate, while subtle notes of oak spice and vanilla linger at the end of the exceptionally long finish. \$70
- **Bin 203 Cuvaison 2007 Napa Valley California**
Soft oak and vanilla notes lend to a finish that is full of creamy butter and ripe pear. \$40
- **Bin 204 Clos du Bois Chardonnay 2007 North Coast of California**
With a brilliant silver and straw hue, this chardonnay rises out of the glass with intense apple, ripe pear and sweet lemon drop scents. \$34
- **Bin 205 Hess 2008 Monterey California**
Monterey's cooling fog and coastal breezes create an ideal climate for growing Chardonnay, yielding wines with tantalizing tropical notes and crisp acidity. The core of this wine comes from a 352 acre Shirttail Creek estate vineyard in Monterey's Costal Valley. \$31

- **Bin 206 Cakebread 2005 Napa Valley California**
This 2005 Napa Valley Chardonnay displays fresh, forward, ripe Granny Smith apple, pear and melon fruit accented by mineral, subtle yeast and warm oak spice tones. Full and lush on the palate, with a mouth-filling texture, its multi-layered apple and pear flavors are enriched by subtle yeast and toasty oak tones that extend into a very long finish. Youthfully compact, with superb structure and an ideal balance of fresh fruit, acid and wood tones. \$55
- **Bin 207 Gordon Brothers 2007 Columbia Valley Washington**
Pleasant aromas of pineapple and toffee greet the nose. Smooth and appealing for its balance, this wine presents flavors of pear, golden delicious apple, citrus zest and cloves. Lively acids invite these flavors to linger on the palate. \$55
- **Bin 208 Joseph Drouhin Pouilly Fuissé 2008 Côte de Beaune France**
Dry and crisp with Granny Smith apple flavors, this is a classic Chardonnay from France. \$36
- **Bin 209 Louis Michel Chablis 2007 Chablis France**
Both fruity and mineral this fine wine expresses all the typicality of the terroir and can be enjoyed after 1 to 5 years. Perfect with a seafood platter, it can also be a perfect aperitif. \$60
- **Bin 210 Lindeman's Reserve 2007 South Australia**
Aromas of white nectarine and subtle grapefruit characters. A long citrus finish complemented by subtle oak. \$29
- **Bin 211 Los Cardos Chardonnay 2008 Mendoza Argentina**
This fruity and expressive wine reflects the great climatic and botanical characteristics of the Ugartheche and Tupungato terroirs, and particularly their ability to produce fresh white wines. These locations allow us to obtain modern wines, especially renowned for their joviality and freshness, with a great aromatic richness typical of the Chardonnay variety. \$36

- **Bin 301 King Estate Pinot Gris 2007 Willamette Valley Oregon**
Aromas of jasmine and crisp pear, a great start to any meal. \$32
- **Bin 302 Willakenzie Pinot Gris 2005 Willamette Valley Oregon**
This wine is made in the Alsatian Style: lush rich and mouth filling. Made entirely in stainless with no malolactic fermentation and no barrel aging. \$39
- **Bin 303 Kris Pinot Grigio 2009 Dell Venezi Italy**
Pale yellow in color with brilliant greenish reflections, enticing aromas of acacia flowers, citrus, tangerine, and hints of apricots and almonds. Kris is lean and refreshing on the palate with hints of blossom and honey. \$33

- **Bin 304 New Gewurz Gewurztraminer 2008 Mendocino County California**
This wine greets you with ripe flavors of pear, apple, grapefruit and lychee and a bit of spice. At the front, there's a hint of sweetness that then flows toward a beautiful dry minerality at the back end. \$25
- **Bin 305 Valley of the Moon Pinot Blanc 2007 Sonoma County California**
Crisp and fresh with aromas of lime zest and citrus blossoms followed by flavors of tropical fruit and honeydew melon with lingering finish. \$28
- **Bin 306 Trimbach Pinot Blanc 2006 Alsace France**
Soft and delicate with a crisp fruity finish. \$27
- **Bin 307 Cline Viognier 2008 Mendocino California**
Fred Cline first planted Viognier in his Sonoma vineyards in 1990. Sensitive to its surroundings, vineyard managers must keep a watchful eye. Grapes are late ripening and have to be picked at the right moment. Cline's Viognier offers rich and distinctive aromas of peaches, apricots, orange blossoms and honeysuckle. \$24
- **Bin 308 Sokol Blosser Evolution NV Willamette Valley Oregon**
The 9 grapes tie together perfectly, creating a smooth, layered white wine that can hold its own or stand up to just about any food pairing you dare to serve it with. It is extraordinarily food friendly, from light salads to the hottest fusion-style cuisine. Regarding the question we're most often asked: 'Were you trying to do this or did your leftovers happen to work well together?' We'll let the success of Evolution speak for itself. \$36
- **Bin 309 Columbia Winery Cellermasters Riesling 2005 Columbia Valley Washington**
The 2005 vintage welcomed a warm and sunny summer followed by a cool, dry autumn. The grapes ripened slowly, creating intensified and balanced fruit flavors. \$30
- **Bin 310 Hogue Columbia Valley Riesling 2008 Columbia Valley Washington**
Opens with a mélange of aromas, orange blossom, jasmine, dried apricot and tangerine. A creamy palate and refreshing finish. \$25
- **Bin 311 "Kung Fu Girl" Riesling 2008 Columbia Valley Washington**
From Charles Smith Wines. Delicate aromas of stone fruit, white peach, apricot, Asian pear and white spring blossoms. "This girl really kicks Ass! - Charles Smith." \$26
- **Bin 312 Ceretto Arneis Blange 2005 Piedmont Italy**
Arneis is a native varietal which produces a very fruity wine with hints of pears and apples. Its fragrance and flavor are also enhanced by the small amount of CO2 kept from the fermentation, which also helps to make up for the variety's low acidity. \$30
- **Bin 313 Martin Codaz Albarino 2007 Rias Baixas Spain**
Aromatic with hints of fresh herbs, peach and apple. Complex, dry and crisp. \$29
- **Bin 314 Giesen Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Marlborough New Zealand**
Classic nettle and gooseberry flavors combine with dry, citrus flavors on a medium bodied palate. Focused acidity provides length and a refreshing zest to the finish. \$28

WHITE WINE CONT.

- **Bin 315 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva Casablanca Valley Chile**
Warm days and cool nights contribute to long, even ripening. Sauvignon Blanc vines are trellised with an interior tunnel to increase airflow so that the grapes don't overheat and retain freshness, aromatics and flavor. Medium body with citrus, melon and herb flavors that linger on the palate. \$25
- **Bin 316 Sauvion Vouvray 2007 Loire Valley Vouvray France**
A romantic wine, smooth and soft. Great for an aperitif or just to enjoy. \$32
- **Bin 317 Pichot Vouvray Domaine le Peu de la Moriette 2007 Loire Valley Vouvray France**
This classic off-dry white is estate bottled from Chenin Blanc grapes in Vouvray, in the Loire Valley region. Low yields, hand harvesting and barrel fermentation are employed to give the wine its authenticity. They call it 'slightly dry' in France, although we would call it 'off-dry'. The aromas are honeydew, peach juice and a hint of spice. The palate is juicy and fresh, and the acidity balances the fruitiness in the finish. \$36



ROSE

- **Bin 400 La Vielle Ferme Rose 2009 Côte du Ventoux France**
Nose-floral, with a touch of aniseed and brown sugar. Palate very rich, balanced, caramel and toffee. \$20

ZINFANDELS & SYRAH

- **Bin 501 Ravenswood Zinfandel 2005 Sonoma County California**
The epitome of mature vine regional Zinfandel. This blend from several vineyards in the northern part of Sonoma County is full, spicy and richly berry-like, but balanced with firm astringency. Most of the grapes are from 60-80 year old vines on the Dry Creek bench land, west of Healdsburg - a location that many wine enthusiasts consider ideal for Zinfandel. \$38
- **Bin 502 Windmill Estates 2006 Petite Sirah Lodi California**
The 2006 Windmill Petite Sirah shows super ripe blackberry and brown sugar flavors and finishes smooth with a touch of oak and spice. \$28
- **Bin 503 Dry Creek Vineyard Heritage Zinfandel 2007 Sonoma County**
The 2007 Heritage Zinfandel is perhaps one of the more balanced and elegant vintages we have had in recent memory. This delicious wine combines fruit from the warm Dry Creek Valley and cool Russian River Valley appellations. Aromas of blueberry and raspberry are framed by notes of white pepper and chocolate. On the palate, an abundance of fresh berry fruit mingle with dollops of creamy oak. The tannins are refined and smooth, giving this wine a long and satisfying finish. \$32

- **Bin 504 Cline Zinfandel 2008 Lodi California**
Severe selection criteria and master blending showcases a wide array of dark berry fruit including black cherry and raspberry. Additionally, spice notes and lasting finish of vanilla from oak aging and firm, supple tannins add complexity to this wine. \$24
 - **Bin 505 Layer Cake Shiraz 2008 McLaren Vale South Australia**
The 2006 Windmill Petite Sirah shows super ripe blackberry and brown sugar flavors and finishes smooth with a touch of oak and spice. \$28
 - **Bin 506 Altico Syrah 2008 Jumilla Spain**
Dry and mineral with hints of ripe red fruits and licorice. Pleasant and persistent finish with balanced tannins that open up in the mouth. \$28
 - **Bin 507 K "Morrison Lane" Syrah 2007 Walla Walla Valley Washington**
Black fruit, black earth and undergrowth, luxurious texture. \$70
 - **Bin 508 K "Northridge" - Wahluke Slope Syrah 2007 Columbia Valley Washington**
Extremely concentrated, intense color. Notes of huckleberry, cedar, cigar and kirsch. Built like a brick shit-house; exuberant ripe fruit with grippy backbone and spice and a seamless finish. \$65
 - **Bin 509 La Landonne 2006 Côte-Rôtie France**
100% Syrah Still tight, with a wall of mocha and raspberry ganache covering the massive core of fig fruit, hoisin sauce and plum cake nose. This is extremely dense but remarkably polished, with a long, tongue-penetrating finish of fruit and spice laid over massive grip. \$350

MERLOT

- **Bin 601 Clos du Bois Merlot 2007 Alexander and Dry Creek Valleys California**
Color of dense black cherry red, aromas of raspberry and black cherry with a touch of vanilla. Sweet tobacco and toasty oak. These rich flavors are encompassed by a silky mouthfeel with hints of oak spice and a long finish. \$36
- **Bin 602 Cypress Merlot 2008 Central Coast California**
Attractive purple color with red hues, dark cherry and currant aromas. On the palate this wine displays bright fruit characteristics with hints of spice and oak. \$26
- **Bin 603 Plumpjack 2007 Napa Valley California**
Restrained elegance is a way to describe Plumpjack Merlot. Primary aromas of baked plums, cardamom, mulling spices and blackberry are followed by secondary aromas of chocolate, vanilla beans and warm fudge. In the mouth primary flavors of berry cobbler, plums and cocoa. \$95

- **Bin 604 Horse Heaven Hills 2008 Columbia Crest East Cascades Washington**

The H3 Merlot entices the nose with aromas of blueberry, cassis and hints of tobacco and spice aromas. The silky and sweet mid-palate introduces slight dusty, earthy, and rich berry notes which cumulate in the long and concentrated finish. \$30

- **Bin 605 Maryhill 2002 Columbia Valley Washington**

This vintage displays aromas of rich cherry and raspberry fruit. Soft on the palate, this wine emits soft undertones of oak. \$26

- **Bin 606 Santa Ema Merlot 2006 Reserve Maipo Valley Isla Del Maipo Chile**

Very fruity wine with aromas of plums, blackberries, and black currant, accompanied by intense notes of caramel, chocolate and vanilla. \$29

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- **Bin 701 Opus One 1999 Napa Valley California**

Opus is a vibrant, elegant wine full of cedar and cassis aromas and flavors one of the best Napa Cabs around. \$190

- **Bin 702 Jordan 2005/2006 Alexander Valley California**

A wonderful wine from the Alexander Valley with herb and currant aromas. Spicy but full of balanced toasty oak. \$80

- **Bin 703 Silver Oak 2005 Napa Valley California**

The 2005 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a nuanced wine that illustrates the results of cool, gradual ripening and a deft balance of varietal components. It has a dark garnet color and a complex nose of boysenberry, truffles, wild game, soy and black pepper. On the palate, the wine has a silky mouthfeel and an elegant, long finish with a slight tannic grip. \$100

- **Bin 704 Frogs Leap 2007 Napa Valley California**

Elegant and refined, the 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of rich black fruit laced with hints of dried herbs. The wine's deep connection to the soil is reflected in flavors of cassis, plum and blackberries which are complemented by the essence of truffle, cedar and tobacco. Soft tannins and well-integrated oak are balanced with a fine acidity to create a finish that will linger well after the last course has been cleared. \$60

- **Bin 705 Quintessa 2001 Napa Valley California**

Beautifully rich fruit flavors and an excellent balance leading to a softly enrobed tannin finish with lingering toffee and chocolate. \$150

- **Bin 706 Columbia Winery 2007 Columbia Valley Washington**

Deep garnet with ripe cherry on the nose. Ripe cherry with cassis and gloves on the palate with tobacco on the finish. A well structured wine that will pair perfectly with a grilled steak. \$28

- **Bin 707 Los Vascos 2007 Colchaugua Valley Chile**
Brilliant red ruby color. Pleasant mature fruit such as red cherries, raspberries and plums. Notes of sarsaparilla and gooseberry jam, glazed dry fruit, red fruit in syrup and white chocolate. \$29

PINOT NOIR

- **Bin 801 Drouhin 2006 Willamette Valley Oregon**
Delicate and balanced with soft raspberry and spice on the nose, oak and cedar finish. \$49
- **Bin 802 Adelshiem 2007 Willamette Valley Oregon**
Rich cedar and cherry notes, finishing with a hint of spice. \$36
- **Bin 803 Erath Pinot Noir 2008 Willamette Valley Oregon**
This classic 'Oregon' Pinot offers luscious aromas of ripe strawberries, vanilla, graham, and a sinful hint of caramel. A silky sweet entry leads to bright flavors of red currant, raspberry and orange peel. The persistent finish is perfectly complemented by a pleasingly buoyant acidity. \$28
- **Bin 804 Elk Cove Pinot Noir 2007 Willamette Valley Oregon**
This Pinot Noir is blended from several select vineyard sites comprised of Pommard and Dijon plant material and shows the softest, most approachable drinking style Elk Cove makes. \$29
- **Bin 805 A-Z 2007 Willamette Valley Oregon**
Lively, refreshing, nice red cherry fruit flavors and hints of red raspberry. A nice food wine with great balance and a long finish. \$30
- **Bin 806 Saintsbury Garnet 2008 Carneros California**
Garnet is produced from Pinot Noir grown in the Carneros district, easy drinking style of Pinot, in that it is full of cherry/raspberry varietal fruit, enriched and developed by aging in French oak. \$30
- **Bin 807 Craggy Range 2008 Martinborough New Zealand**
Deep blackish red. Dark brooding fruit aromas of black cherry, boysenberry with florals, truffle and tar. Dense yet elegant and poised. The finish gradually unwinds revealing bright red berry and violets. \$55

RED WINE

- **Bin 901 Justin Isoscelles 2006 Paso Robles California**
The 2006 ISOSCELES is inky purple with a slight red hue around the rim. Aromas of blackberry, black plum, leather, mocha and cassis combine with light layers of caramel, vanilla and a touch of smoke resulting from the extended oak aging. \$90
- **Bin 902 Valley of the Moon Sangiovese 2005 Sonoma California**
Fresh blackberries and clove mellowed by aromas of oak and hints of black pepper. Well structured with a long, lingering finish. \$30

- **Bin 903 Marietta Old Vine Red Lot 53 Sonoma California**
Old Vine Red is loaded with spicy, peppery, ripe blackberry fruit and backed by dense, blueberry, earthy Petite Syrah flavors. The higher percentage of Petite Syrah adds noticeable complexity to the wine. This is a serious wine, yet eminently approachable... is broad and lush on the palate with a lingering finish. \$28
- **Bin 904 Jacuzzi Valeriao 2005 Estate Carneros California**
Valeriano is a flavorful blend of traditional Bordeaux and displays rich cherry and herbal characters with a full mouth feel with great structure and enough tannin to provide backbone without being overbearing. \$70
- **Bin 905 Angeli Cuvee "Marietta Cellars" 2006 Sonoma California**
The combination of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah and Carignane blend harmoniously with toasty oak assuring for an ongoing evolution of flavor and aromatic complexity. \$45
- **Bin 906 Cyrus Vineyards 2002 Alexander Valley California**
There's aromas here of black cherry, dark chocolate and exotic spices and rich flavors of plum, blueberry and mocha. \$60
- **Bin 907 "The Boy" K Vintners 2008 Walla Walla Washington**
90% Grenache, 10% Syrah. Like all K Vintners wine, the fruit is hand picked, foot crushed and fermented with only native yeasts. This wine is all about intensity- especially in terms of aroma. Expect room-filling aromas: spicy sanguine, earthy, and all red fruits. \$75
- **Bin 908 L'Ecole N° 41 Apogee 2003 Walla Walla Washington**

- **Bin 910 Produttori del Barbaresco 2006 Barbaresco Italy**
Made entirely from Nebbiolo grapes, Barbaresco is a wine of great complexity and elegance. Aromas of black cherry and violet combine with spicy notes to create its distinct taste, supported by firm tannins and a long finish. \$48
- **Bin 911 Condado De Haza 2005 Ribero del Duero Spain**
Tempranillo 100%. 22 months in American oak barrels and 14 months in the bottle. \$57
- **Bin 912 Campo Viejo Tempranillo Riserva 2004 Rioja Spain**
Good structure with velvety texture. Combining flavors of ripe fruit and vanilla. \$32
- **Bin 913 Kaiken Malbec 2007 Mendoza Argentina**
The wine presents a vivid ruby red color with purple hues. On the mouth, red fruits and elegant spicy touches enhance its complexity, mixing harmoniously with the oak. Soft and silky on the mouth, where the wine's fruit intensity is instantly recognizable, blending perfectly with the oak aging. Its unique structure, due to the maturity and softness of its tannins, provides a long and persistent finish. \$30

- **Bin 914 El Portillo Malbec 2007 Uca Valley Mendoza Argentina**
Deep ruby red with shades of violet. Rich with fruit, the nose is reminiscent of plums and blackberries. Tannins as soft as velvet set the stage for an enviably round finish. \$28
 - **Bin 915 Chateauneuf-Du-Pape-Guigal 2003 Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur France**
Round tannins with powerful complexity. A rich unctuous wine with notes of mature plums, hazelnuts and red fruits. \$50
 - **Bin 916 Chateau Saint Pierre 2005 St. Julien France**
A very beautiful red, with blackberry, licorice and current on the nose. Full-bodied, with velvety tannins and lots of smoke, berry, coffee and dark chocolate flavors on the finish. \$160
 - **Bin 917 Chateau Giscours 2005 Margaux France**
Displays blackberry, cherry and hints of sweet tobacco. Full bodied with soft velvety tannins and a long caressing finish. Very pretty and solid. \$180
