



## Wedgewood Wildlife Sanctuary Rules & Safety

### **Sanctuary Rules:**

- The sanctuary is limited to foot, stroller and wheelchair traffic.
- Please stay on the trails to avoid disturbing wildlife and delicate plants.

### **Prohibited:**

Wedgewood Wildlife Sanctuary is a reserve for birds, mammals, flora and fauna.

To protect the ecosystem and habitat we strictly prohibit dogs (leashed or unleashed\*), bicycling, swimming, snowmachines, ATVs, fishing, hunting, falconry, shooting, trapping, alcohol, smoking, picnicking, camping, bonfires, and fireworks.

Collecting plants or insects without permission is prohibited.

***\* Service dogs with proper identification and clean-up materials are allowed***
